Italian IFFR Fly In weekend 2024



Friday 13 September 2024

Located on the tip of the boot, overlooking the sea, Reggio Calabria, the oldest colony of Magna Graecia in southern Italy, is a city rich in history and culture, celebrated by English and French travelers of the 1800s, attracted by an always favorable Mediterranean climate. Razed to the ground by the earthquake of 1908, it was rebuilt in the Art Nouveau era.





The seaside village of Chianalea **BETWEEN SCYLLA AND CHARYBDIS** a journey through time between myth, history and traditions. Houses are built directly on the rocks, separated by narrow streets that descend to the sea, where time seems to have stopped, that of Chianalea is considered one of the most beautiful villages in Italy.

The Strait of Messina, the stretch of water that separates the Calabrian coast from the Sicilian one, is rich in suggestions far away in time; A place of pirate raids that have ravaged these

waters since the fifth century B.C., starting with the Tyrrhenians, very skilled sailors, and then the Greeks and Romans, it is, still today, crossed by the spadare that with their elegant gait are intent on perpetuating the ritual of swordfish hunting. It is the place of the myth of Scylla, a nymph of shocking beauty, transformed by the sorceress Circe into the horrendous monster that for centuries, according to legend, has been fatal in the waters of the Strait together with Charybdis, a devastating sea creature created by Zeus capable of swallowing and rejecting sea water three times a day.

Homer in the Odyssey, Ovid in the Metamorphoses, Virgil in the Aeneid, Dante in his Divine Comedy speak of it.





Saturday 14 September 2024

One of the most prestigious archaeological museums in Italy, dedicated to Magna Graecia, it houses the Riace Bronzes and material from excavation campaigns conducted throughout the Calabrian territory, from Prehistory to the late Roman Age.







GALA DINNER AT A GOURMET L'ACCADEMIA A gastronomic journey with local raw materials. A restaurant housed in a noble palace of the early '900, overlooking the "most beautiful kilometer in Italy" are offered sea and land dishes whose protagonists are the products of the Calabrian territory, Gourmet dishes served between the sea of Scylla and Charybdis and the magical Aspromonte. For chef Filippo Cogliandro "Cooking is like making a wonderful journey of the senses through the products offered by our sea and our land".

GERACE ... Nestled in the territory of the Aspromonte National Park, the ancient village stands out from the top of the sandstone cliff on which it is perched. Proud, elegant, with an exceptional charm, it still preserves its medieval urban setting. The history of Gerace is closely linked to that of Locri Epizephiri.

It developed only after the abandonment of the city of Locri, which took place starting from the seventh century AD, due to the increasing pirate danger.

Due to its particular position, Gerace soon became a centre of exceptional importance in Southern Calabria; the possibility of controlling coastal traffic, its particular orographic conformation that allowed a natural fortification, meant that it became the object of attention of both the Byzantine Empire and the Kingdom of Sicily.

Squeezed between the sea and the mountains, it is characterized by high and jagged coastlines which, with a height of about 600 meters, are among the most impressive cliffs in the world, as well as graceful and evocative. From Monte Sant'Elia it is possible to enjoy a superb panorama with the archipelago of the Aeolian Islands and the two active volcanoes, Etna and Stromboli, in the background, up to Capo Vaticano. The coastal road crosses the slopes covered with Mediterranean scrub.




